## **Summary of Duties**

The successful applicant will teach various courses in Fisheries at the undergraduate levels, and develop and lead postgraduate programmes in Fisheries; conduct research in areas of his/her professional academic interest, supervise students' research projects at all levels, and carry any other duties as delegated by the supervising officer(s). A major part of their job is to carry out all standard duties related to teaching and learning in an academic institution. SINU requires staff in the Higher Education stream to carry a work load of, on average, 16 contact hours per week. The rest of the time is to be devoted to non-contact aspects of teaching & learning, including programme development and reviews (estimated to average 10 hours per week), and research & publications.

## Minimum Qualification and Experience Requirements:

- A doctorate level qualification in Fisheries / Fisheries Science
- At least 15 years of formal tertiary teaching and research experience or a combination of education and commercial experience of at least 15 years at the commensurate level for a professorial appointment, and 10 years of respective experience for Associate Professorial appointment.
- Solid experience in programme development and review, and
- A good record of publications in credible academic outlets.

Applicants for professorial rank must have at least 15 single authored papers (or equivalent) in leading academic journals in the field and must display the standard characteristics of a professorial standing. For Associate professorship applicants must have at least 10 single authored papers (or equivalent) in leading academic journals in the field and must display the standard characteristics of an associate professorial standing standing.

Desirable: Preference will be given to applicants with work and/or teaching experiences in developing countries, and a demonstrated experience in dealing with sociocultural and political diversities.
Remuneration: Cash remuneration (including Salary and Gratuity), starts at \$312,000 for Associate professor, and \$370,000 for Professorial ranks. The University also provides 7.5% of salary as the employer contribution to the national superannuation scheme. Housing support is also provided.
