Position Responsibilities

The successful applicant will teach various units in Management at the undergraduate level and develop and lead postgraduate programmes in Management; conduct research in areas of his/her professional academic interest, supervise students' research projects at all levels, and carry any other duties as delegated by the supervising officer(s). It is required that the candidate must carry out all standard duties related to teaching and learning in an academic institution. SINU requires staff in the Higher Education stream to carry a work load of, on average, 16 contact hours per week. The rest of the time is to be devoted to non-contact aspects of teaching & learning, including programme development and reviews (estimated to average 10 hours per week), and research & publications.

Minimum Qualification and Experience Requirements:

To be considered for this position, applicants must have:

- Either: a doctorate level qualification in Management, with some tertiary teaching experience and at least one article in a credible journal and 1 conference paper,
- OR: a good Masters degree in Management, with at least 10 years of formal tertiary teaching experience, and at least two articles in credible journal(s) and 6 conference papers.
- Some experience in programme development and review is necessary

Desirable: Preference will be given to applicants with work and/or teaching experiences in developing countries, and a demonstrated experience in dealing with sociocultural and political diversities.

Remuneration: Gross cash remuneration (including gross salary and gratuity) in the range SBD194,000 to SBD250,000 depending on the rank AND point placement of the appointee. The University also provides a number of benefits, like a Cost of Living Adjustment (COLA) if approved by Council; a partly furnished housing or a rental subsidy (equivalent to upto 15% of gross salary), and 7.5% of gross salary as the employer contribution to the national superannuation scheme.
