Qualification & Experience Requirement	 Either: a doctorate level qualification in Management, with some tertiary teaching experience and at least one article in a credible journal and 1 conference paper, OR: a good Master's degree in Management, with at least 10 years of formal tertiary teaching experience, and at least two articles in credible journal(s) and 6 conference papers. Some experience in programme development and review is necessary.
Desirable	Preference will be given to applicants with work and/or teaching
Attributes	experiences in developing countries, and a demonstrated

Remuneration and Benefits	Gross cash remuneration (including gross salary and gratuity) in the range SBD194,000 to SBD250,000 depending on the rank AND point placement of the appointee. The University also provides a number of benefits, like a Cost of Living Adjustment (COLA) if approved by Council; a partly furnished housing or a rental subsidy (equivalent to upto 15% of gross salary), and 7.5% of gross salary as the employer contribution to the national superannuation scheme.
