

Library services during COVID-19

It is now mandatory for all students, staff, and visitors to be fully vaccinated if entering University campuses or to take part in face-to-face University activities. You may be asked to show your Student ID cards, vaccine pass. Library services and operations are described below:

1.Before entering the library

- 1. Entrance is on left side of the building.
- 2. A tap is proved there to wash your hands before entering the library building.
- 3. A hand sanitizer is placed on the circulation counter and different locations inside the library.
- 4. Always wear face mask.

2. Library Spaces

Library spaces are limited as we maintain covid-19 protocols.

- 2.1.1 Only 114 sitting spaces are available in the library
- 2.2.1.To secure a seat, contact circulation desk staff for seat tokens

Description of seat tokens

- a. Orange seat tokens are for upstairs
- b. White seat tokens are for downstairs

- c. Green seat tokens are for computers
- d. Maroon tokens are for printing and photocopy services
- 2.2.2. You are to surrender your IDs or Vaccination cards for seat tokens and collect them upon leaving the library.
- 2.2.3. Avoid sitting on Study carrels that are marked with signs.

3.Browsing the shelves



Browsing of shelves are forbidden. Follow the instructions below:




4.1.1.Using the catalogue.
