Working	Carry out all standard duties related to the SINU library system. SINU library requires staff in the General Support Service stream to carry a workload of, on average, 37.5 contact hours per week 24/7 except on public holidays in the above-assigned locations if required.
Administration & General Responsibilities	Staff are also expected to participate in University-wide activities commensurate with the roles and responsibilities of the said post.
