## **A. ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF CURRENT CHALLENGES**

The suggestion for a dedicated library for the Faculty of Nursing is one of many ideas that merit consideration as we seek to address these spatial constraints.

Furthermore, the frustrations associated with the limited availability of computer labs and printing facilities are concerns that cannot be overlooked. The inconvenience of waiting for available terminals and the high costs associated with printing services are issues that detract from the overall learning experience. The absence of a comprehensive university bookstore and other essential services, which are standard offerings at universities globally, has also been noted with concern.

I empathise deeply with your situation and understand the disparities between the services provided and the expectations held. It is a reality I have observed firsthand in other academic institutions, where student services are managed efficiently, often with significant input and management from student unions. This model presents a viable path for us at SINU, provided we establish robust accountability systems to ensure transparency and effectiveness in service delivery.

The financial challenges of maintaining and enhancing a university's infrastructure and services are substantial. The full cost of providing a comprehensive range of services that meet the expectations of a quality university education often exceeds the revenue generated from tuition and fees. This underscores the critical need for government support and commitment to higher education, recognizing that the development of a nation's intellectual capital is foundational to its progress and prosperity.

However, we cannot solely rely on governmental support. It is imperative that we embrace innovation and creativity to identify and exploit alternative revenue streams. By leveraging our assets, including our physical properties and academic programs, we can generate additional income to support and enhance our services. This approach requires a concerted effort from all stakeholders within the university community, including the administration, faculty, and students.

Our commitment to improving our systems and processes is unwavering. The current state of our student admission and registration services, which remains labour-intensive and inefficient, is a clear indicator of the urgent need for investment in digital and automated systems.
