Step 1: Collect Application form

Step 2: Payment of application fees

Bachelor programme's are a duration of 4 years of study.

Bachelor of Science in Tropical Agriculture (NBTA)

Successful Completion of Form 7 Arts/Science with minimum GPA of 3.0 and above OR Completed Diploma of Tropical Agriculture with minimum GPA of 2.5 and above OR graduated with Certificate in Agriculture with minimum of 3 Years work experience in the Field of Tropical Agriculture.

Bachelor of Fisheries Studies (NBFS)

Completed Form 7 Science or Foundation Science with minimum GPA of 3.00 and above OR Successful completion of Diploma of Fisheries Studies with GPA of 2.5 & above OR completed Form 6 with 5 Years' work Experience in relevant industry or organization.

Bachelor of Environmental Studies (NEW)

Successful Completion of Form 7 with pass in Math, Science, English & Social Sciences OR Minimum GPA of 3.00 and above OR Form 6, Form 6 mature aged candidates with 5 or more years of work experiences in relevant fields OR Completed Diploma of Environmental OR Completed Certificate in Environment with minimum GPA of 3.00 and above

Bachelor of Forestry Science (NEW)

Successful Completion of Form 7 with pass in Math, Science, English & Social Sciences OR Minimum GPA of 3.00 and above OR Form 6, Form 6 mature aged candidates with 5 or more years of work experiences in relevant fields OR Completed Diploma of Tropical Forestry OR Completed Certificate in Tropical Forestry with minimum GPA of 3.00 and above

Diploma of Tropical Agriculture (NDA)

Completed Form 7 or UPCIV with minimum GPA of 2.5 OR Completed Form 6 Arts/Science with minimum aggregate of 1.5 and less OR Graduated with Certificate in Tropical agriculture, Forestry and environment with minimum GPA of 2.0 and above OR Has minimum work experience of 3 years for in related work sectors.



Certificate

Certificate programmes are a duration of 1 year of study

Certificate in Tropical Forestry (NCTF)

Completed Form 6 Arts/Science with minimum aggregate of 1.8 and less OR mature entry with minimum of 3 years' work experience in related field.

Certificate in Environmental Studies (NCE)

Completed Form 6 Arts/Science with minimum aggregate of 1.8 and less OR Successful completion of short courses on environmental studies OR Mature entry with minimum of 2 years' work experience.

Certificate in Fisheries Studies (NCFS)

Successful Completion of F7 Science with minimum GPA of 2.0 OR Complete F6 Science with minimum aggregate of 10 and less OR Has minimum work experience of 3 years in related work industry.
