The University Preparatory Certificate Program (UPC) or the Learning Pathway Education (LPW) Program is designed and developed for Forms 3, 5 & 6 leavers and those being discontinued in Form 4 and the examination classes. The Program provide students with pathways to allow them to prepare for higher certificates and Technical Educational Training at SINU and other institutions.

The UPC/LPW consisted of three (3) programs: - (A)
University Preparatory Certificate 1 (B) University
Preparatory Certificate 2 and University Preparatory

Certificate 3.

University Preparatory Certificate 1 (UPC1)
This program is specifically designed for Form 3 leavers and dis-continued Forms 4 & 5 students. This program bridge students to the University Preparatory
Certificate 2 (UPC2) (Form 5 equiva-lent). Students who scored 70 and above in any of their form 3 subjects will cross credit their pass grades and only upgrade the subjects they failed. Students graduating in the UPC1 Program can apply to other Vocational Centres in the country, also, can continue on to do the UPC2 Program. The program has six (6) units and can be completed in two semesters.
