1. the decision of the First Defendant dated 28th September 2020 is brought up to this Court and quashed;
2. the decision of the Second Defendant dated 5th November 2020 is brought up to this Court and quashed;
3. a Government employment policy is not a requirement prescribed under the *Labour Act (Cap 73)* and *The Work Permit Rules* for the purposes of assessing work permit applications of foreign nationals;
4. the work permit applications of Ganeshwar Chand, Vinod Narayan Sami and Maikali Tokaiburega Naikawakawavesi satisfy the requirements prescribed in the *Labour Act (Cap .73)* and *The Work Permit Rules*;
5. the First Defendant must issue necessary work permits to Ganeshwar Chand, Vinod Narayan Sami and Maikali Tokaiburega Naikawakawavesi forthwith;
6. the persons named in Order 5 hereof be granted necessary exemptions to re-enter Solomon Islands;
7. upon compliance with orders 5 and 6 above, the Claimant shall file a notice of discontinuance;

8. the parties to bear their own costs.
