- Establish and manage regular backup procedures to safeguard web content and data.
- Monitor website security and respond promptly to any security incidents.

Design Coordination and Improvement

- Coordinate website and Intranet design improvements per SINU's corporate image guidelines.
- Collaborate with stakeholders to gather requirements for design updates and enhancements.
- Implement design changes that improve user experience while maintaining SINU brand consistency.

External Vendor Management

- Coordinate effectively with external hosting providers and web developers to optimize website and Intranet performance.
- Manage requirements and expectations with internal and external partners to ensure timely delivery of services.
- Maintain productive relationships with vendors to support ongoing website operations and improvements.

Technical Administration

- Manage web servers and ensure optimal performance of all web-related services.
- Troubleshoot technical issues and implement solutions to minimize disruption to web services.
- Advise on web-related budgetary needs and resource requirements.
