SOLOMON ISLANDS NATIONAL UNIVERSITY ORDINANCE

ORDINANCE FOR DELEGATION OF CONTROL OVER UNIVERSITY FACILITIES

Under and by virtue of the powers conferred upon me by Sections 29 and 30(2)(b) of the Solomon Islands National University Act 2012, I, Professor Transform Aqorau, Vice Chancellor and Acting Pro Vice Chancellor Corporate of Solomon Islands National University, do hereby promulgate the following Ordinance:

1. Title and Commencement

- This Ordinance may be cited as the "University Facilities Allocation Ordinance 2024" and shall come into force on the date of its signing.

2. Vesting and Use of University Facilities

- The ownership and control of all University assets, encompassing facilities within the three existing campuses and any future campuses of Solomon Islands National University, both within

and outside Honiara, are hereby vested in the University. These facilities shall be made available for use by any faculty, department, institute, or centre established by the University for the purposes of conducting classes, conferences, meetings, and organised social or academic activities, subject to the procedures and approvals outlined herein.

- 3. Delegation to the SINU Properties and Facilities Committee
- The power to allocate and control the use of the University's buildings and classrooms is hereby delegated to the SINU Properties and Facilities Committee. This Committee shall act in consultation with the deans, heads of schools, directors, and managers of the respective faculties, departments, institutes, or centres.
- 4. Duties of Deans, Heads of Departments, and Directors
- Deans, Heads of Department, and Directors shall maintain a duty of care towards all students and staff, ensuring that facilities are accessible for academic purposes, and as needed, for University-organized social activities. It shall be their continuous obligation to consult with one another and coordinate the booking and usage of facilities for academic and related activities.
- 5. Compliance with the SINU Act
- It shall be deemed inconsistent with the SINU Act 2012 and the principles of this University for any party to hinder the core academic and educational purposes of the University through the misuse or misallocation of facilities.

This Ordinance is made to ensure the effective management and utilisation of University facilities in accordance with the highest standards of governance and academic integrity.
