The Solomon Islands National University (SINU) was established under the Solomon Islands National University Act 2012 that became effective as of January 1st 2013, replacing the former Solomon Islands College of Higher Education (SICHE). By global standards, SINU is a very young University in a developing country context, but with much aspiration and determination.

SINU implemented its three-year Transitional Plan from 2013 to 2015. Following a comprehensive review, a five-year Strategic Plan (2016–2020) was developed and successfully executed. Building on this foundation, the University launched its successor Strategic Plan (2021–2025) in June 2021, aimed at consolidating SINU's growth and strengthening its position as a leading institution of higher learning. The current plan sets ambitious goals, including the development of new, attractive, and relevant quality degree programs; the provision of enriched teaching and learning experiences; and enhanced support for both students and staff. Since its establishment, SINU has introduced twenty-two Bachelor programs, three postgraduate diploma programs, and two Master programs; established a Research Department; and undertaken significant infrastructure development projects. Today, SINU enrols approximately 6,000 students annually and employs more than 600 staff across its campuses.

The Vice-Chancellor provides strategic leadership and direction to strengthen and consolidate SINU's position as a fully established university, building on recent reforms and institutional advancements to elevate its standing among leading universities regionally and globally. The University is seeking a leader with the vision, expertise, and resilience to drive SINU's ambitions, balancing resource constraints with the need to deliver on high expectations and transformative reforms.
