The School of Sciences welcomes everyone to apply with the following requirements:

#### For BSc;

- Form 7 (Year 13) or UPC L4 science students with a GPA of 2.5 and above.
- Pass in Form 7 (Year 13) science subjects or equivalent from any tertiary schools abroad with a GPA of 2.5 and above.
- Students who have graduated with diploma in science subjects or equivalent from any tertiary schools abroad with a GPA of 2.5 and above.
- Students who did not complete BSc programme in other universities.
- In-service students who have Diploma in science and have worked or teach for 5 years or more.

#### For DipCE;

#### **PRE-SERVICE**

- Form 6 Science Students with a Pass in Mathematics, Subject & a Pass in Physics Subject.
- Form 6 Arts Students with a Pass in Mathematics
- Subject and a Pass in Accounting or Economics Subject

#### IN-SERVICE

- Students with at least 5 years Work Experience, having Certificate IV in Carpentry and Plumbing.
- Students with Diploma in either Technical Fields such as Surveying, Electrical, Mechanical or Construction.

## **HOW TO APPLY:**

#### **Step 1: Collect Application form**

You can pick up your application form and program list at the Student Academic Services (SAS) Office at Kukum Campus or conveniently download them from the SINU website: www.sinu.edu.sb under the announcements section.

#### **Step 2: Payment of application fees**

Pay the \$50.00 application fee via direct deposit BSP Account: 9088870419, BSP EFTPOS at the front counter, or mobile transfer (please send a confirmation to Phone#: 7240059 with your name. This is for verification purposes. You will need to wait one day before visiting the Finance department).

#### **Step 3: Submit receipt**

- Submit deposit receipt to the finance revenue team for an invoice and payment receipt.

#### **Step 4: Submit application**

It is important that once you get the receipt from SINU Finance you can submit your applications at the SAS office, ensure to attach it with:

- Your completed SINU application form
- Certified copies of Certificates, Academic results or Transcripts
- A certified copy of your Birth Certificate
- A sponsor's letter of agreement (applicable only to those who have secured sponsorship)
- A reference letter or any supporting documents from employer (for In-service entries)
- A certified copy of passport size photo.

Reminder: Any application form received without the above will not be considered.
