

Admission and Assessment Process Summary

The Solomon Islands National University welcomes all prospective students to apply for admission into our Diploma and Bachelor programs. The following provides an overview of our assessment and admission process.

1. Application Submission

Applicants must complete the official SINU Application Form and submit it to the Student Academic Services (SAS) Office before the closing date. Each application must include:

- Certified copies of academic certificates and transcripts
- Identification document (birth certificate & ID Photos)
- Receipt from \$50.00 (SBD) for application fee (*Receipt is obtained from SINU Finance Office*)
- Supporting documents such as employer reference or CV (for mature entry or work experience pathway)

2. Admission Requirements

Bachelor Programs

Applicants must meet at least one of the following:

- Form 7 or UPC IV with GPA ≥ 2.5
- Relevant Diploma with GPA ≥ 2.5
- Mature entry: At least five (5) years of relevant work experience supported by an employer letter and CV

Diploma Programs

Applicants must meet at least one of the following:

- Form 6 with aggregate ≤ 16 points
- UPC III with GPA ≥ 2.5
- Certificate/Certificate IV in a related field
- Work experience pathway: At least three (3) years of relevant employment with supporting documentation

3. English Language Requirement

- Bachelor programs: Pass in English at Form 7 (minimum grade B)
- Diploma programs: Pass in English at Form 6 (minimum grade B)

If studies were completed in English, this requirement may be waived.

4. Entry Test Requirement

Applicants for certain programs (such as Nursing, Teaching, and Health-related programs) are required to pass an entry test before receiving an offer of admission.

5. Progression from Diploma to Bachelor

Students progressing from a SINU Diploma to a Bachelor program must:

- Provide official proof of completion (graduation certificate or completion letter)
- Meet the entry requirements for the Bachelor program
- **Note:** SIG sponsorship does **NOT** automatically qualify students for admission.

6. Assessment Outcome

After assessment, applicants will be informed of one of the following outcomes:

- Qualified – Meets all requirements
- Conditional Offer – Pending minor documents
- Test Pending – Awaiting test results
- Not Qualified – Does not meet minimum requirements



Successful applicants will receive an official Offer Letter from SINU via email or in person.
