Summary of Duties

The Lecturer in Medicine is responsible for the design, delivery, and continuous improvement of teaching, learning, and assessment activities within the Faculty of Nursing, Medicine, and Health Sciences. The role encompasses curriculum development, supervision of clinical training, research, consultancy, and contribution to community and professional service. The incumbent will support the University's mission to deliver high-quality medical education and research aligned with national health priorities.

Key Responsibilities

- Deliver lectures, tutorials, and clinical sessions that promote evidence-based and practical learning.
- Develop, review, and update course materials, assessments, and curricula in accordance with current medical standards.
- Design and implement structured clinical learning experiences for students at the National Referral Hospital (NRH) and provincial health facilities.
- Supervise and mentor students and clinical tutors in both academic and clinical environments.
- Conduct and publish research that contributes to medical knowledge and public health improvement.
- Collaborate with internal and external stakeholders to enhance the quality of medical education.
- Participate in program reviews, quality assurance processes, and accreditation activities.
- Provide academic guidance and professional development support to students and staff.

- Master's Degree in a relevant field of Medicine or Health Sciences.
- Certificate in Teaching or equivalent tertiary teaching qualification.
- Minimum of five (5) years teaching and/or professional practice experience in medicine.
