Summary of Duties

*The **Tutor – Therapeutic Massage (CBR)** is responsible for delivering high-quality instruction and practical supervision in therapeutic massage and rehabilitation. The role includes curriculum support and development, assessment and mentorship of students, coordination of clinical placements, and provision of physiotherapy services through the University's rehabilitation clinic. The Tutor ensures the application of professional standards, contributes to faculty initiatives, and supports quality assurance processes aligned with the University's strategic objectives.*

Key Responsibilities

- Deliver lectures, tutorials, and practical sessions in therapeutic massage and rehabilitation.
- Develop lesson plans, teaching materials, and assessments.
- Supervise students during clinical and rehabilitation sessions.
- Provide massage and rehabilitation services to clients in the SINU Rehabilitation Clinic.
- Maintain clinic operations, equipment, and compliance with safety standards.
- Mentor students and promote professionalism, ethics, and effective communication.
- Contribute to curriculum development and quality assurance activities.

Key Performance Indicators (KPIs)

Performance in this role will be assessed against the following deliverables:

- Deliver high-quality teaching and clinical instruction in therapeutic massage and rehabilitation.
- Supervise and assess student performance in practical and clinical settings.
- Maintain accurate student records and timely reporting of academic progress.
- Support clinic operations and ensure safety and hygiene standards are met.
- Encourage student engagement, professional development, and research participation.
- Contribute to continuous improvement in course content and instructional methods.
