Summary of Duties

The Lecturer in Medicine is responsible for delivering high-quality teaching and clinical education within the Faculty of Nursing, Medicine and Health Sciences. The role involves curriculum development, supervision of clinical training, research, consultancy, and active contribution to community and professional service in support of national health priorities.

Key Duties and Responsibilities

- Deliver high-quality lectures, tutorials, and clinical teaching in medicine.
- Develop, review, and update curricula, learning materials, and assessment tools in line with current medical standards.
- Coordinate and support clinical teaching and supervision at the National Referral Hospital and provincial hospitals.
- Design structured clinical learning experiences that meet program outcomes.
- Prepare, administer, and assess student examinations and assignments.
- Provide academic advising, mentoring, and support to students.
- Conduct and publish research relevant to medical education and national health priorities.
- Contribute to quality assurance, accreditation, and continuous improvement initiatives.
- Support Faculty planning, reporting, and collaborative initiatives.
- Foster effective teamwork, mentoring, and professional engagement.

Minimum Qualifications and Experience

- Master's Degree in Medicine or a related Health Sciences discipline.
- Certificate in Teaching or equivalent tertiary teaching qualification.
- Minimum five (5) years' experience in teaching and/or professional medical practice.
- Demonstrated clinical competence and subject-matter expertise.
- Experience in tertiary or clinical education settings.
- Proficiency in Microsoft Office and online learning platforms.
